**FLOOD PREPAREDNESS/CONTINGENCY PLAN**  
**FOR THE YEAR 2024**

The Brahmaputra and its tributaries such as Nanoi, Saktola and Barnadi criss cross across the flood plains of Darrang District. Sipajhar Revenue Circle is constituted with 93 revenue villages. Geographically, Sipajhar is situated 5 km away from Nanoi and 10 km from Barnadi. During the monsoons the river outrages its volume and maroons many villages and inundates large tracts of agricultural land causing loss of livelihood of the people. To help the affected population and to re-establish themselves necessary steps have been taken by the concerned authorities with the help of various departments and organizations located within the territory of Sipajhar Revenue Circle.

A Contingency Plan has been made to strengthen the preparedness to mitigate the disaster and loss during devastation of flood in the Circle area. It is designed how the various departments and organizations will undertake the rescue and relief operations. This plan includes the facts and figures that have been collected from various formal and informal sources. Collection and classification of datas are to be updated in May every year.

The villages of Sipajhar Revenue Circle has been as such divided into 5 (Five) Zones with Zonal in- Charge to conduct the Relief and Rescue operation smoothly during flood.

Prompt understanding and initiation of immediate action will make a big difference in the prevention of loss of human lives, crops and property damages during the time of disaster. The role and responsibility of the Response Team is not only important during disaster but also critical before and after the occurrence of a disaster.

For smooth functioning of the overall works during Flood emergency, Sector Officers for all the Gaon Panchayats under Sipajhar Revenue Circle have been deputed.

Major role of the Sector Officers will be, to monitor the Relief camps, Distribution of GR items, reporting time to time about the flood situation etc.

Besides the duties and responsibilities allotted to the Lot Mandals of the Revenue Circle, they are also to assist the Zonal-in-Charge of their respective Lots in their duties.

Moreover, to monitor and evaluate the Relief and Rescue Operation a **Core Response Team** is formed by Zonal-in-Charges & NGO Representative headed by Circle Officer. When the disaster strikes, a meeting is held by the core team along with the response team to formulate the course of required actions. The Core team members will assist the concerned In-Charge for response as per their area requirements.

For the other In-Charges like Health, Security, Fire service etc. will be communicated directly by the Core Response Team whenever the service required.

## **TRAINING:**

A sensitization meeting arranged by the Circle Office inviting the NGO's, Youth Groups, Village Level Clubs, Organizations along with the Stakeholders. Also a Circle Disaster Management Committee has been formed including all the concerned officials of various departments.

Chief of response team i.e. Circle Officer will arrange day long training programme for response team as well as core committee members for clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities. Circle Officer will also have to arrange training for the volunteers, their services during disaster with dignity.

## **RELIEF COMMITTEE:**

A relief committee has been formed with the following members. The Committee will look after the activities of response team, assists and advise them for proper services. Before the response, the relief committee meeting will be called by the Circle Officer for discussion about the response preparedness.

**ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DIFFERENT AGENCIES/ LINE DEPARTMENTS FOR FLOOD**

## MANAGEMENT

**1. CIRCLE OFFICER:** Take up steps for implementation by the various authorities as per the recommendations of DDMA meeting on flood preparedness. Select sites for evacuation centres and relief centres in safe areas. The site for sheltering livestock may be decided in consultation with district A.H. & Veterinary Officer. Prepare a sub-division wise list of Officers and staff available for deployment of relief duty as and when called for.

**2. MEDICAL TEAM:** A medical team consisting of Doctors and Para Medical Staff been set up for every relief camps. The medical team will provide all necessary medical aid to the inmates of the relief camps.

A separate Mobile Medical Relief Team consisting of Doctors and Para Medical Staff will visit the flood affected areas, Raised Platforms and Shelter Camps regularly and take necessary Relief measures. One Senior Doctor will be in charge of the team and look after all adequate medical relief measures need to be taken on the event of flood. The Joint. Director Health, Darrang is requested to depute one Nodal Officer and submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025 to the undersigned and also keep available stock of sufficient medicine, phenyl etc. for relief camps.

**3. DIST. AGRICULTURE DEPT:** The Dist. Agriculture Officer, Darrang will assess the area and farm family affected by the flood and will prepare a list of farm families affected with the help of Revenue personal just after receding the flood water. He is requested to depute a Nodal Officer and also to submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April.

**4. PUBLIC HEALTH ENGINEERING CELL:** P.H.E will install at least 2(two) nos. of hand tube well in each relief camps for drinking water purpose. PHE will also construct temporary latrines in each relief camps as per need basis and keep available sufficient quantities of bleaching powder, phenyl etc. For relief camps. The **Ex. Engineer, PHE**, is also requested to depute a Nodal Officer and also to submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April. to the undersigned.

**5. CATTLE FEED DISTRIBUTION:** Circle Officer Patharighat will be the overall incharge of the cell. The Dist. Vet. Officer and SDVO are also requested to depute a Nodal Officer and also to submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April. The Vety. Officer will pre identify spot/venues & make necessary arrangement for shelter of live stock during flood. The Vety. Officer will keep stock of sufficient medicines etc. for the live stock.

**6. IRRIGATION DEPT.:** The Ex.Engineer will identify the vulnerable points of Irrigation Structures like head work, cross drainage, canal embankment and canal system, Prepare a list of Irrigation Personal for round the clock patrolling of irrigation structures. Follow the flood warning system at the upstream release of water. Repair vulnerable structures. The SE & EE are requested to depute a Nodal Officer and also to submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April.

**9. SOCIAL WELFARE DEPT.:** The Dist. Social welfare Officer (SWO) will visit generally flood affected areas pre flood and make arrangements for mobile units of maternity and child welfare centres likely to be affected in flood. Draw up nutrition programs for children's through Anganwadi Centres. Make a list of voluntary social welfare organizations and list of personals for rendering service in relief centres. The SWO is requested to depute a Nodal Officer and also to submit a contingency plan in this regard within 25<sup>th</sup> April.

**10. POLICE:** Prepare a list indicating the number of Police personnel, Civil Defence and Home guards likely to be deployed in addition to the Police personnel in the existing Police stations and outpost for purpose of Law & Order, Rescue and Evacuation. Keep the Police Vehicles and equipment's in good working conditions. Arrange for required number of police wireless sets to be kept in readiness for temporary installation in the affected areas. Assists in rescue operations and evacuation or transfer of affected people to relief camps or safer places through providing security to the rescuers. Post police guards at vital installations and arranging guard for relief materials at the relief camps.

**11. FOOD & CIVIL SUPPLIES:** Arrange for the procurement of controlled commodities like rice and maintain a reserve stock of the required quantities of these items in specified places. Ensure adequate supply position of essential commodities, particularly the controlled commodities. Keep constant vigil by the supply staff so that the traders do not take advantage of the situation and create any condition of artificial scarcity. Deploy Staff for relief in the affected areas.

**12. Relief material (GR) collection cell:** A GR cell will be constituted consisting of the following Officers and employees. The team will keep records of GR collection properly in a Register. The Circle Officer will be overall in charge of this cell.
