A BRIEF OF ACTIVITIES OF DARRANG WATER RESOURCES DIVISION, MANGALDAI.

The Darrang Water Resources Division, Mangaldai is dealing with flood and erosion problem since its establishment in October/1985.

JURDICTION OF DARRANG WATER RESOURCES DIVISION:

The river system of Mangaldai Water Resources Division consists of river Brahmaputra on the south and the tributary river Barnadi, Nonai, Noanadi, Saktola and Mangaldai, Tangni, Dhansiri flows from the North towards the south. This tributaries cross the NH-15 at Dumunichowki, Khanndajan, Punia, Bordoulguri, Mangaldai town, Fakirpara and Dhansiri ghat respectively.

The Division has two Sub-division known as Mangaldai-Dalgaon Water Resources Sub-District & Sipajhar WR Sub-District

The reach of Brahmaputra dyke under Jurisdiction of Darrang Water Resources Division starts from Chereng Ghat and ends at Kurua hills. Besides that one ring bundh was provided from Upper Kurua to Bhati kurua for a length of 2.45 Km.

All the scheme executed in the river Brahmaputra and its tributaries in different parts of Darrang district since inception of this division successfully saving live and properties of the people living in the district to great extent expect some occasional incidents.

MAIN TASKS OF DEPARTMENT

A) Before Disaster:-

Before the onset of monsoon period, field staffs have been engaged in difference activities like Clearing of jungle, stacking and spreading of earth on the embankment as per requirement. Vulnerable points of the embankments are detected and preventive measures have been provided as per site requirement and availability of fund. Requisition empty cement bags, and other flood fighting materials are sent to the higher authority for engagement of contractors to supply the same. Construction of bamboo works are also made to reduce erosion problem as per necessity of erosion affected site. Repairing of sluice gates are done with the help of Guwahati Water Resources Mechanical Division.

B) During Disaster:-

During disaster this department engages manpower to rescue, relief and temporary restoration of road communication with the help of local people. Strict vigil of dyke system is made through department staff round the clock. Daily Flood report and water level report is sent to the higher authority. Immediate restoration work is also carried out if necessary with proper direction from the higher authority.

C) Post Disaster:-

In case of any damage to embankment , sluice gate and culverts the Water Resources Department takes up necessary restoration works with due approval of District Administration and Chief Engineer , Water Resources Department.

Rolls & responsibility of B.P.H.C level health team

- Over all In charge Is The S.D.M & H.O /Dy. Supt. I/C BPHC.
- Mapping Of Health Institution In The Flood Prone Area.
- Planning the duties of health workers including doctor & office staff.
- To establish contact with local circle officer if any.
- To plan to seek help of fire & emergency services if and when necessary.
- To enlist the name & contact no of local PHE I/C for utilization of their services in need.
- To contact the officers in-charge of local APDCL station.
- BPHC & sector wise separate flood for preparedness plan to be developed with the help of BPM & ABPM respectively under the administrative control of the BPHC.
- The BPHC level plane should be prepared in such away that the prepared plan could be utilized in the time of needs.
- The SMO to look after the duties in the BPHC & help the SDM & HO if & when necessary over and above his/her routine duties .
- MO: To help SMO& SDM& HO In need over and above his routine duties at the time of flood situation.
- Pharmacist: to maintain all day to day required medicine and logistics along with BPHC level control room during the flood situation. He/ she may take help of other workers from the PHC as admissible.
- BPM: BPM is the overall manager of the situation in consultation with the SDM & HO,
- BDM: He/she must keep all & accurate data daily and to report to the SDM & HO, BPM as well as DPM in real time. After receiving the data the SDM & HO will share the report of day long activities with the jt. DHS Darrang for further course of planning and for immediate further action to address the problem.
- All ASHA supervisor, ASHA, ANMS, MPW, SW, BHW even GNM & all other office staff should be involved to mitigate the arrised unexpected situation in very energetic way.

Rolls & responsibilities at the level of district

- The jt. Director of health services Darrang is the overall in-charge of the district.
- The nodal officer of flood: to take account of over all activities related to manage the flood situation in the district.
- Nodal officer of epidemic situation: we all know during & after the flood situation various type of epidemic may occur. To collect the information related to epidemic situation plan & execution of plan goes under the responsibilities of the nodal officers concerned.
- Epidemiologist: Epidemiologist should always be alert to collect all information from all affected arises and proceed for investigation and take immediate affective action of the situation areas .
- DSO: DSO is the nodal person to lead the IDSP Team. So she should manage the situation with the help of her IDSP staff in proper consultation with the joint DHS .
- Nodal Officer Maternal And Child Health: The nodal officer has crucial roll to takle the problem that is very much sensitive. He/she must take action to collect the information regarding maternal & child health during the flood situation .This group of people are very vulnerable. So the nodal officer must take immediate action to solve the problem.

- Team RBSK: The whole team must be ready at any time to tackle the situation arises due to flood.
- Officials of program management unit & office of the jt. DHS are to be always ready for proper action on their allotted duties .they should move anywhere at any period of time if necessary.
- DPM: DPM is overall manager of the situation involving all human resources under this department.
- DME: Specially DME is responsible to collect the information from the field & disseminate the awareness among the affected people.
- District drug ware house managers: To keep all essential drugs & consumables ready for 24hrs delivery (supply) if needed. The drugs store management as well as to make availability of drugs & consumables is the roll and responsibility of the DDSM.
- Ambulance services : At least are ambulance with driver to be keep ready to handle any kind of patient transportation during the period of flood situation.
- DMO: To keep ready all necessary materials to cope up the situation regarding vector born diseases. All workers under the control of DMO from the district office (as well as from the thru peripheral institution of necessary) should be engaged to address the issues .
- Rapid response team : At least one rapid response team consisting of district nodal officer ,district surveillance officer & no of office assistant to be kept ready to respond any kind of situation promptly.
- Superintendent of district hospital: Superintendent is to engage all level of hospital staff to receive, manage, keep proper records & submit the report related to the patients/daily activities in real time.
- At least 5no of bed for female and 5no. female patient affected by flood situation to keep ready always for their daily use
- All drugs & consumable including life saving drugs to be kept ready for all the time during flood situation.
- Laboratory technicians: They are to be in place with all equipment & reagents to perform of test the sample send/collected from the field/patient & to perform the test properly, keep record & submit the report immediate.

- Operative procedures :
 - A. Preparedness:
 - Office of the jt. D.H.S is to prepare the district flood action plan & go ahead accordingly.
 - All SDM & HO I/C all BPHC have to prepare own block level flood action plan to utilize during the flood situation.
 - Sectoral medical officers are also to prepare their own action plan accordingly.
 - Mapping of all flood prone area by all level of health institution & keep ready to use at the time of flood proper planning for utilization of man power & logistic should be ready in place of use.
 - To make available all kind of essential medicine and other logistics well before flood situation.
 - Planning must be there to communicate with other related department at the time of need.

B. During Flood:

- THE JT. DHS is over all in charge of supervising and monitoring activities. He/she is to monitor all activities of health worker along with all level of management.
- The DNO and DPM are the important persons to monitor the services provided by all level of health worker and to inform the jt. DHS daily about the situation for further course of planning and other activities.
- Block level officers to activate their health workers to renders services in the affected area. He is to monitor all activities of the health workers engaged in the field under his jurisdiction and to collect the correct and reliable data to inform the jt. DHS in real time.
- Sectoral medical officers are responsible for all activities like the SDM & HO. He/she is to communicate all information to the respective SDM&HO in real time.
- Rapid response team to visit the area immediate from the block and sector respectively
- All BPM will help SDM &HO for every activities to manage the flood situation
- BDM/ABPM are responsible for collection, compilation, analysis data and to submit it to the office of the jt.DHS through the SDM &HO in real time basis.
- DDM/DM, IDSP will be responsible for collection of data from all BPHC analyze it, compile and forward to the state after proper information to the jt.DHS.
- DDSM is to supply all essential drugs and consumable constantly to cope up the situation.
- DSO, district epidemiologist and DMO along with their team will take appropriate measures for prevention and control of disease outbreak.
- DCM & DFPC will take necessary steps for pregnant ladies and lactating mother along with children in the flood affected area if and when situation demands.
- DME to developed communication network and guide for mobilization of health team.
- DAM& ADAM to provide all financial help according to the guidelines.
- DIO to ensure vaccination to children and pregnant woman in flood affected area.

C. After flood:

- Arrangement for health camps (by block/district) to be done.
- Appropriate measures to be taken to prevent disease outbreak.
- Public awareness and counseling of effected people to be conducted.
- Assessment of damage & initiative for restoration & reconstruction to be done.
- IEC activities to be continued among the affected population regarding prevention of any kind of dieses outbreak.

D. Budget requirement :

- Mobility for health team.
- Refreshment for the health team.
- Drugs and other commodities.
- IEC/BCC activities.
- Post flood fogging and sanitation measures.
