Minutes of the District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee (DISHA) meeting held on 10th January, 2025 (4th Quarter of FY 2024-25)

A meeting of the District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee (DISHA) of Darrang district was held on 10th January, 2025 (4th Quarter of FY 2024-25) which was chaired by Sri Dilip Saikia, Hon'ble MP, Darrang Udalguri HPC cum Chairman, DISHA.

After taking of chair by the Hon'ble Chairman, DISHA, Sri Manas Das, CEO, Darrang ZP has given the welcome address, followed by review of the minutes of the last DISHA meeting and department wise review of progress.

3	Aadhar Bridged Payment System (ABPS) under MGNREGA	Increase of Aadhar Bridged Payment System (ABPS) under MGNREGA	CEO, ZP has stated that help is needed from Hon'ble MP, MLAs and all other concerned to achieve desired percentage of ABPS. All has expressed their willingness for help so that the workers can avail the benefit from MGNREGA. The Chairman has asked LDM to offer necessary help from banking side in increasing ABPS. The LDM was also asked to arrange meeting before 26 th January, 2025.	All concerned including LDM
4	Roads under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyaan (PM JANMAN) Scheme and PMGSY	Submission of proposals for Roads under PradhanMantri Jan Man Scheme and PMGSY	PWD (roads) was asked to submit proposals for Roads under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyaan (PM JANMAN) Scheme (development of roads in tribal areas) and PMGSY in consultation with Hon'ble MP and MLAs for covering maximum nos. of roads. 5	Increase of production of local fishes and AmritSarovars as an unit for increasing production of fish	Plan for utilizing Amrit Sarovars for increasing production of fish	As there are a total of 101 nos. of Amrit Sarovars have been constructed in the district, the Chairman has asked Fishery Deptt. to utilize these water bodies for increasing fish production in the district. He has expressed that this step will definitely impact in occupying fish markets with local fishes.	P&RD and Fishery Deptt.

			<p>He has also urged the Fishery deptt. to make field studies and to take steps for increase of production of local fish, so that inflow of fish from outside can totally be stopped.</p> <p>Hon'ble MLA Sipajhar has urged to resolve the issue of flood damage and water retaining problem of the Amrit Sarovars.</p> <p>As DFDO has highlighted the shortage of required staffs, Hon'ble Chairman has asked to write through DC for additional staffs for the district as well as for the project at Garukhuti.</p>	
6	PMAY(U) and PMAY(G)	To ensure maximum coverage of eligible beneficiaries	<p>Hon'ble Chairman has asked the Municipality Boards for taking up steps (online) for increasing targets so that no one eligible left out.</p> <p>In regards to PMAY (G), he has said that the left out eligible need to be covered in the forthcoming inclusion process.</p> <p>Villages of three GPs have been included in Sipajhar Municipality Board. Some beneficiaries are in PWL of PMAY(G), but not yet benefitted. The Chairman has asked to resolve the issue so that they can avail houses from PMAY(U).</p>	P&RD and Municipality board
7	PHED	Schemes under PHED and Water supply facilities in Municipality board areas, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)	<p>As asked by Hon'le Chairman, PHED has highlighted one of their project 'Gobardhana' about its possibility to contribute bio-energy source. The Chairman has asked PHED to prepare short video on the project so that all can share it for more awareness as well as more inclusion.</p> <p>The PHED has highlighted the pipeline damage issue of the JJM schemes (PWSS) caused by development activities of other deptts. Hon'ble Chairman has asked PHED to submit a status report to him within a week. He has expressed satisfaction on implementation of JJM.</p> <p>The chairman has asked DC to convene a meeting with the contractors of the ongoing JJM schemes for resolving issues and for early completion of the schemes.</p> <p>The Chairman has said that the Municipality board can avail the water supply facility from the 'Amrut' schemes.</p>	PHED, Municipality board
8	Social Welfare	AWCs, CDPO offices, Model AWCs and other programmes	<p>As asked by the Chairman, the deptt. has highlighted different programmes under Social Welfare deptt. The deptt. has said that there are AWC which have not their own building. Many AWCs are running in rented houses, in schools or in clubs. Proposals are sent to state for merging of such AWCs with nearby schools.</p> <p>As highlighted by Hon'ble MLA, Mangaldai LAC and Hon'ble MLA, Sipajhar LAC, the meeting has resolved to shift the CDPO office of PachimMangaldai ICDS and other departmental offices from the rented houses to the school buildings which are lying vacant after merging it with other schools.</p> <p>On the matter of Model AWCs, the chairman has asked to take steps for early completion of the constructions.</p>	Social Welfare
9	Health and Family Welfare	Proposal for new hospital, manpower and other issues	<p>The Hon'ble Chairman has asked the H&FW department to take steps for improving health & wellness and health related education in the district.</p> <p>The meeting has resolved propose a fifty bedded hospital in Dalgaon.</p>	H&FWD

			On the shortage of manpower issue, the Chairman has asked to resolve to send proposal to govt. for filling the shortages as far as possible. The meeting has resolved to stop the Urban Health Centre .	
10	F&CS	Issue of NFSA cards	Hon'ble Chairman has asked for reports from F&CS deptt. on issue of ration cards in fair price shops, alleging that abrupt high nos. of cards were issued in some specific fair price shops showing priority. The Chairman and the Hon'ble MLAs have expressed their dissatisfaction over functioning of the F&CS deptt. The chairman has asked DC, Darrang to inquire into the allegation on card distribution as well as other issues with one ADC and with members of the DISHA (Binu Ram Boro and Nilima Devi), especially in the areas where there are allegations/ complaints. 11	PWD (Building)	Quality of works	The chairman has asked the PWD (Building) to ensure quality in all construction.	PWD(Building)
12	Education	Transfer and posting	Hon'ble Chairman has asked for a good spirit from all in regards to quality education. It was reminded for shifting of the female teachers from Char areas to main land by posting young teachers there. The Chairman has asked the deptt. to send proposals to state for the same. The Hon'ble MP and MLAs have urged for consultation with them before any transfer and posting.	Education deptt.
13	Agriculture	Organic farming and minimizing pesticides, herbicides etc.	As the DAO has requested for a proposal to establish an Organic farming training centre at Darrang district, the Hon'ble Chairman has agreed the same and urged for minimizing use of pesticides etc. and to encourage organic farming. The Hon'ble MLA, Dalgaon LAC has asked the deptt. for controlling of pesticides as well as the spreading of unauthentic rumours on heavy use of pesticides which has adversely effected the farmers of Kharupetia area. 14	All Departments	Road map for future	The Hon'ble Chairman has asked all departments to prepare futuristic road map on holistic development of the people of the district.	All Departments.
