The District Development committee meeting for the month of May held today on the 21st May, 2025 with an aim to review the progress of ongoing schemes and programmes of the different departments and to resolve the inter departmental issues. The meeting was chaired by Shri Parag Kumar Kakaty, ACS, District Commissioner, Darrang. At the very outset, the District Commissioner Darrang welcomed all the members present at the meeting and initiated the discussion on the action points of the last DDC meeting.

After threadbare discussion, following decisions were taken at the meeting.
